### **Moderator Prerequisites**

1. Be an Active, Associate, Public Utility, Public Agency, Sustaining, Life or Honorary Member.
2. Possess a current IMSA certification, ideally at the highest level, e.g. Traffic signals, Level 3; Signs & Marking, Level 3; Work Zone Traffic Supervisor or 5-years experience in Michigan Temporary Traffic Control.
3. Written letter of support from candidate's employer, if applicable.
4. The ability to communicate related experiences with students and commitment to dedicate personal time to further the goals of the Michigan Section IMSA.
5. Successful completion of IMSA Educational Methodology and final Board approval.

### **IMSA Moderator**

The Michigan Section will be conducting a one day program titled Educational Methodology on February 12, 2016. This one-day program will prepare you to understand the necessary skills to moderate IMSA certification programs. Members of the MI Section Board will be present to observe the Activity segments. The Board's decision will be mailed to each candidate within seven days.

### **MI Section Moderator Prerequisites**

1. Be an Active, Public Agency or Life Member.
2. Written letter of support from candidate's employer, if applicable.
3. Commitment to dedicate personal time and related experience to the MI Section Board governance.
